Risk Landscape in a Post COVID-19 Era

He has published extensively in both international and Chinese journals, and is author of International Trade (Peking University Press, 2009). He has been invited to give speeches to executives of multinational enterprises and Chinese companies on issues related to the global and Chinese economies. Dr. Xu is a four-time recipient of the CEIBS Teaching Excellence Award (2009, 2010, 2014, and 2016).
